

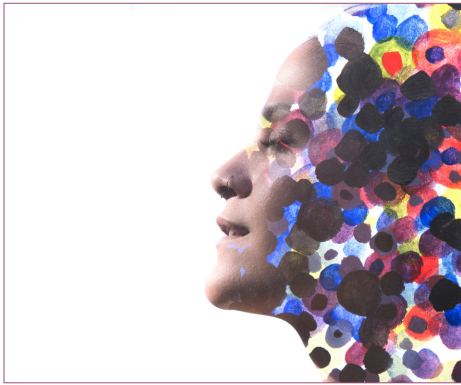
### IN PURSUIT OF EXCELLENCE:
